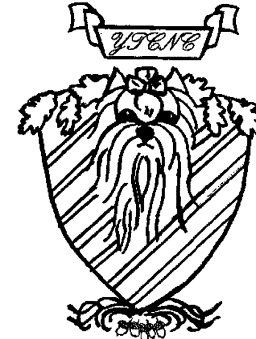

Non-Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch: for dogs and bitches 7 years of age or older. Winners of these classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Spayed/neutered allowed with full AKC registration.

Best of Breed Competition

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Award of Merit

One Award of Merit offered for every three (3) Champions entered in Best of Breed, to be awarded at Judge's discretion to recognize superior quality.

Best Bred By Exhibitor

To be chosen from the first place winners of the Bred By Exhibitor Dog and Bitch classes. The entry must be handled by the Breeder. If a Best Bred By entrant is awarded BOB or BOW, it is automatically awarded Best Bred By Exhibitor.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class: Open to stud dogs and two of their get. Stud Dog and get do not necessarily have to be owned by the same person. Get must be entered in a Regular or Non-Regular Class at this show. Award will be based on the merits of the get.

Brood Bitch Class: Open to brood bitches and two of their produce. Brood Bitch and produce do not necessarily have to be owned by the same person. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class or Non-Regular Class at this show. Award will be based on the merits of the produce.

Special Attraction — Parade of Champions

For Yorkshire Terriers over six months that are AKC Champions of Record. This class is a non-competitive exhibition class. Each entrant in the Parade will receive a rosette. Entry fee for the Parade will be \$15.00. Full particulars must be given for each dog on Official AKC Entry Form if the Parade is the only entry for the dog.

RADISSON HOTEL RATES
